Low Lead Embellishments



Floral Treasure Box

SUPPLIES:

- Suze Weinberg's Signature Edition Hot Wax Art[®] Stylus
- Kandi's Professional Touch[®] HotFix Applicator
- Floral fabric
- 5" Round chipboard box
- Celery green ¼" picot ribbon (Offray)
- Pink and clear Hot Wax Art Beeswax Pigments
- Jonquil, Light Rose, Topaz CraftSafe[™] HotFix Crystals
- Faux pink gerbera daisy (unknown brand)
- Cork
- Elmer's Craft Bond Adhesive

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut 5" diameter circle from floral fabric. Mount to top of cover of chipboard box using Elmer's Craft Bond Adhesive. Let dry.
2. Cut fabric strip wide enough (for my box 2 ½" high) to cover outside of box. Mount using Elmer's Craft Bond Adhesive. Let dry.
3. Apply clear Beeswax over all fabric surfaces using the Hot Wax Art[®] Stylus.
4. Use Hot Wax Art[®] Stylus to apply pink bees wax to outside edge of cover.
5. Mount green picot ribbon around top edge of cover using Elmer's Craft Bond Adhesive. Let dry.
6. Wrap cork in fabric strip and mount to top center of box.
7. Use Elmer's Craft Bond Adhesive to mount pink gerbera daisy to top of cork.
8. Use the Hot Wax Art[®] Stylus to mount CraftSafe[®] Topaz Crystals around outside center of flower.
9. Use Professional Touch[®] HotFix Applicator to mount Light Rose and Jonquil crystals (alternately) onto ribbon around edge of cover, approximately 1" apart.
