- Suze Weinberg's Signature Edition Hot Wax Art<sup>®</sup> Stylus
- Kandi's Professional Touch<sup>®</sup> HotFix Applicator
- CraftSafe<sup>®</sup> 4mm Jonquil & Topaz crystals
- Hot Wax Art<sup>®</sup> Metallic, Ocean and Natural Pure Beeswax Pigments
- Tropical leaves, burlap, beach sand, sand dollar patterned papers (miscellaneous brands)
- Grass paper (Magic Scraps)
- Burnt Umber Pallet Inkpad (Stewart Superior)
- Brown cardstock (Paper Accents)
- Rebecca Sower Nostaliques typewriter key epoxy alphabet stickers
- Elmer's Craft Bond Adhesive
- Purple Cows trimmer

### INSTRUCTIONS - For Crystal Palm Tree:

1. Cut brown cardstock to 10 3/4" x 4 1/2". Cut sand dollar paper to 10 3/4" x 4 1/2". Mount sand dollar paper onto cardstock. Fold in half to form card.
2. Cut grass paper to 3 1/2" x 4".
3. Cut tropical leaf patterned paper to 3 1/2" x 4". Tear edges to approximately 3" x 3 1/2". Ink edges with brown inkpad.
4. Cut brown cardstock to 2" x 3 1/2"
5. Cut sand patterned paper to 1 7/8" x 2 3/8". Ink edges with brown inkpad.
6. Layer sand paper onto brown cardstock, mount onto torn leaf paper, then onto grass paper. Mount onto front of card.
7. Use Kandi's Professional Touch<sup>®</sup> HotFix Applicator to mount Jonquil and Topaz CraftSafe<sup>®</sup> Crystals in palm tree shape on sand patterned paper.
8. Add strip of sand paper and torn square of tropical leaf paper to inside of card.

### INSTRUCTIONS - For Hot Wax Art Palm Tree:

1. Cut leaf patterned paper to 7 3/8" x 8 1/4". Fold in half to form card.
2. Cut brown cardstock to 2 1/4" x 7 3/8". Mount to center of front of card.
3. Cut burlap patterned paper to 3 1/2" x 6 1/2". Ink edges with brown inkpad. Mount onto center of card front.
4. Use Hot Wax Art<sup>®</sup> Stylus and assorted shades of brown pigment wax to create trunk of of palm tree.
5. Use Hot Wax Art<sup>®</sup> Stylus, metallic green and dark green pigment wax to create leaves on palm tree.
6. Use typewriter key epoxy stickers to spell out "Aloha" on card front.
